Of this manor the Count of Mortain holds 1 hide in PRESTON,  
which was (part) of the lordship revenue before 1066. Land  
for 4 ploughs. 2 ploughs there. The value was and is 40s.

lordship; 2 ploughs there; 6 slaves;

From this manor has been taken away a customary due of  
Brushford, the Count of Mortain's manor, that is 24 sheep  
a year, which were paid there before 1066. Mauger keeps  
it back through the Count.
