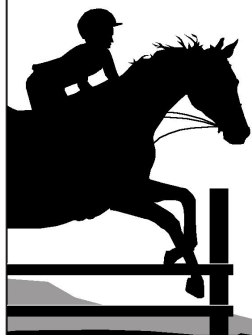

HORSE SHOW & GYMKHANA RULES

1. The Judge's decision is final.
2. The organisers accept NO responsibility for accident, injury, loss or damage to any person, animal or vehicle attending the show. All competitors take part **AT THEIR OWN RISK.**
3. Riding hats conforming to current safety standards with a harness and no fixed peak to be worn at all times when mounted. All riders must wear appropriate footwear (**no trainers allowed**) .
4. Saddles and stirrups must be used in all gymkhana events and safety stirrups are recommended. No whips or spurs are allowed in the gymkhana.
5. In ridden classes, horses must be aged 4 years or over
6. Competitors failing to enter the ring as directed will be liable to disqualification.
7. Age as on day of the show.
8. Galloping is NOT allowed on the show ground and will result in elimination.
9. All horses to be kept within designated areas.
10. Horses judged to be unsound will not be allowed to compete in any class.
11. All dogs to be kept on leads.
12. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry with or without reason.

RING 1 - SHOW JUMPING

Starts 9.00am Judge: Carly Martin-Pope

Number of entries may be restricted if class is oversubscribed

Class 1 Novice 2ft approx. Combination not to have been placed in a show jumping event. Special rosettes to the highest placed adult rider, and child under 8 years.
For the St Mary's Vase.

Class 2 Novice 2ft 3ins. Combination not to have won a first prize in a show jumping event.
For the Ferret Cup.

Class 3 Scurry 2ft 6ins. One round against the clock.
For the Ruggs Cup.

Class 4 Novice 2ft 9ins. Combination not to have won at this height or above.
For the Webber Perpetual Shield

Class 5 Open Jumping. Jump height approx 3ft.
For the Scott Cup

Prize Money: Classes 1-5 1st £5.00 2nd £3.00 3rd £1.50 Rosettes to 6th place

Class 23 Working Hunter 14.3hh and over.

Class 24 Working Hunter Pony 14.2hh and under.

For the Canty Cup.

Class 25 Nursery Working Hunter Pony 13.hh and under. May be led, riders 12 years and under.

For the Andrews Cup.

Class 26 Retrained Racehorse to be judged on general condition and way of going.

For the Allendale Perpetual Cup.

Class 27 Leading Rein Pony. Not exceeding 12.2hh, rider 8 years and under. Pony to be shown in a snaffle bridle with lead rein attached to noseband.

For the Pincombe Perpetual Challenge Cup.

Class 28 Veteran In hand or ridden. Horse/pony must be over 15 years.

For the Bodwelly Silver Memorial Trophy. A special rosette will be awarded to the best veteran over 25 years (not the winner).

Class 29 Family Horse/Pony. Suitable to be ridden by any family member.

For the Exmoor Rotary Perpetual Challenge Cup.

Class 30 Coloured Horse/Pony – Ridden (inc. Dun, palomino, Appaloosa etc).

For the Peggy Woodman Cup.

Class 31 Pony Club Pony. May be asked to do a small jump.

Special Rosettes for Best Foal and Best Yearling.

Class 35 Exmoor Pony** - 4 years and over. Ridden.

(EPS Rosette for Best Ridden)

For the Exmoor Cup.

Mini Championship for 1st and 2nd in Classes 32-35 For the Shircombe Perpetual Challenge Cup

RING 3 - CLEAR ROUND JUMPING

Clear Round jumping will start at 9.00am at a height of 1ft 6ins and will run throughout the day in this ring.

Entry Fee: £1.00 at ringside. Rosettes to all clear rounds (*see First Aid cover on reverse)

Championship rosette for most clear rounds. Also, clear round jumping on foot for children with dogs - Have a go!

RING 3 - NURSERY STAKES JUMPING

Class 7 Nursery Stakes. Ponies 12.2hh and under, riders 10 years and under. Jump height approx 1ft 6 ins
