COOKERY, FLOWER, VEGETABLE, EGG AND HANDICRAFT SHOW RULES

1. Entry fee – per item: **50p for Open Classes & Children under 16 FREE**
2. Entry forms are available in the Village Shop.
3. All completed entry forms and entry fees must be placed in a sealed envelope in the box provided in the Village Shop. **Please use separate envelopes for each Show you enter and help us by writing the name of the Show you have entered on the front of the envelope.**
4. No entries will be accepted on the day.
5. Exhibitors are limited to one entry per class.
6. Open classes are open to any age. Note the specific age restrictions for the Children's Classes.
7. **ALL ITEMS MUST BE AVAILABLE FOR DISPLAY IN THE SHOW TENT BY 9.45AM.** The Show Tent will be open from 9.00am.
8. Judging will start promptly at 10.15am. Access to the Shows will be closed while judging is taking place.
9. The Children's Classes will be awarded prize money and there will be certificates in all classes to those placed 1st, 2nd and 3rd. The Judges may also award Highly Commended certificates. Any certificate may be withheld or modified at the Judge's discretion. The Judge's decision will be final.
10. If space is limited, the Show Organiser and Judge reserve the right to decide which exhibits are displayed. **All such exhibits will remain on display until 3.30pm. Thereafter, they will be included in the Auction unless exhibitors take them away by 4.00pm at the latest.**
11. Any objection must be made to the Show Secretary, in writing, before 3.30pm on the day of the Show and accompanied by a fee of £5, which will be returned if the objection is upheld. The decision of the Committee, or an Umpire appointed by the Secretary, will be final.
12. No dogs to be taken into the Show Tents except dogs for the blind.
13. The submission of a signed entry form shall be deemed to be acceptance of these conditions.
14. The Committee's Jubilee Award will be presented to the individual scoring the most points overall across the five Shows: Cookery, Flower, Handicraft, Vegetable and Egg Shows. Points will be awarded as follows: 3 points for 1st, 2 points for 2nd and 1 point for 3rd.

ADDITIONAL NOTES

Flower and Vegetable Shows

The Committee reserves the right to inspect the gardens of exhibitors on or after the entry date. Unless otherwise stated all exhibits must be owned by the exhibitor and have been in their possession for at least two months before the Show.

Vegetable Show

Root vegetables must be cleaned with tops trimmed – suitable for display.

Handicraft Show

Please attach firmly your NAME and CLASS to all exhibits.

Items may have been exhibited at other shows but not previously exhibited at this Show.

Exhibits in the Children's Classes may have been made at school.

Egg Show

The Committee reserves the right to inspect the poultry of exhibitors on or after the entry date.

ALL TROPHY AND CUP WINNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR OWN ENGRAVING AND FOR ANY LOSS OR DAMAGE
