Root vegetables must be cleaned with tops trimmed – suitable for display

OPEN CLASSES

1. Three white potatoes
2. Three coloured potatoes
3. Three tomatoes
4. Five pods of peas
5. Three onions
6. Two lettuces with roots
7. Pair of cabbages with 3" of stem
8. Three carrots
9. One cucumber
10. Three individual runner beans (with stems attached)
11. Three round beetroot
12. Longest runner bean
13. One stem of three different herbs in a container of water
14. Three courgettes (flowers attached if possible)

15. Five french beans (with stems attached)
16. Any other vegetable
17. Display of home grown vegetables NOT to exceed a total weight of 10lbs including the basket which is to be decorated

6 COOKERY, FLOWER, VEGETABLE, EGG AND HANDICRAFT SHOW RULES

1. Entry fee – per item: **50p for Open Classes & Children under 16 FREE**
2. Entry forms are available in the Village Shop or on **www.bromptonregis.com/show**
3. Completed entry forms and entry fees should be placed in a sealed envelope in the box provided in the Village Shop by midday on the Friday before the show day. Please use a separate envelope for each show you enter. Alternatively, entries may be emailed to bromptonregisshow@gmail.com and entry fees paid to the show organiser on the day.
4. No entries will be accepted on the day.
5. Exhibitors are limited to one entry per class.
6. Open classes are open to any age. Note the specific age restrictions for the Children's Classes.
7. **ALL ITEMS MUST BE AVAILABLE FOR DISPLAY IN THE SHOW TENT BY 9.45AM.** The Show Tent will be open from 9.00am.
8. Judging will start promptly at 10.15am. Access to the Shows will be closed while judging is taking place.
9. There will be certificates in all classes to those placed 1st, 2nd and 3rd. The judges may also award Highly Commended certificates.
10. The winner and runner up in the children's classes will be awarded tokens. These may be redeemed at all stalls and attractions at the show (excludes Styles Ice Cream). The individual token value is £1 but they have no monetary value outside of the showground.
11. The judge's decision is final.
12. If space is limited, the Show Organiser and Judge reserve the right to decide which exhibits are displayed. **All such exhibits will remain on display until 3.15pm. Thereafter, they will be included in the Auction unless exhibitors take them away by 3.30pm at the latest.**
13. No dogs to be taken into the Show Tents except guide dogs and assistance dogs.
14. The submission of a signed entry form shall be deemed to be acceptance of these conditions.

ADDITIONAL NOTES

Flower and Vegetable Shows

The Committee reserves the right to inspect the gardens of exhibitors on or after the entry date. Unless otherwise stated all exhibits must be owned by the exhibitor and have been in their possession for at least two months before the Show.

Handicraft Show

If you wish, your name may appear on exhibits but it will be obscured/ removed for judging

Items may have been exhibited at other shows but not previously exhibited at this Show.

Exhibits in the Children's Classes may have been made at school.

Egg Show

The Committee reserves the right to inspect the poultry of exhibitors on or after the entry date.

Data protection

Officers of the Show Committee will only store your personal details for the purposes of the organising and running of Brompton Regis Show & Gymkhana ('The Show'). It may be stored both electronically and on paper for future Shows. Your details will not be passed on to any third party without your consent. If you wish your details to be removed following The Show, please let a member of the Show Committee know.
